

**Prof. Dr. Mojib Latif**

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Prof. Latif is a Professor for Climate Physics at the Leibniz Institute of Marine Sciences at Kiel University since 2004. Besides his teaching activities, he is Head of the Research Division "Ocean Circulation and Climate Dynamics".

He was born in 1954 and received his diploma in Meteorology at Hamburg University in 1983, where he later obtained his Ph.D. in Oceanography. He conducted research projects at various leading institutes in his area, such as the Scripps Institution of Oceanography in La Jolla, California. His main research interests are climate variability and predictability, anthropogenic climate change and model development and inter-comparison.

Prof. Latif is an internationally outstanding scientist. He received several awards, among them the Sverdrup Gold Medal Award of the American Meteorological Society, the Max Planck Award for Public Science and the Lifetime Award of the Deutsche Umwelthilfe.
