HOPS - PESTICIDES - 2010



This sheet lists some pesticides used on hops. The health symptoms listed may be caused by things other than pesticides. If you feel sick after exposure to pesticides, call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. If a person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, give artificial respiration.

Abamectin (Agri-Mek)	12 hours	NOSE, EYE, OR THROAT IRRITATION IRRITATION VOMITING WEAKNESS
Bifenthrin (Brigade)	12 hours	SKIN IRRITATION VOMITING DIZZINESS
Copper Hydroxide (Kocide)	24 hours	NOSE, EYE, OR THROAT IRRITATION IRRITATION IRRITATION ON THE CASE OF THE CASE
Imidacloprid (Admire, Nuprid)	12 hours	STOMACH WEAKNESS
Metalaxyl/Mefenoxam (Ridomil Gold)	48 hours	NOSE, EYE, OR THROAT IRRITATION IRRITATION
Paraquat (Gramoxone, Firestorm)	24 hours	NOSE, EYE, OR THROAT IRRITATION IRRITATION IRRITATION
Propargite (Omite)	21 days	NOSE, EYE, OR THROAT IRRITATION IRRITATION PROBLEMS
Sulfur (Micro Sulf)	24 hours	NOSE, EYE, OR THROAT IRRITATION IRRITATION BREATHING PROBLEMS

If you are exposed to a pesticide spray or drift:

- Leave the area
- Tell your employer
- Immediately rinse skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes
- If you get pesticides in your eyes, hold eyes open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. If you wear contacts, rinse for 5 minutes, remove contacts and continue rinsing eyes.
- Change into clean clothes
- Always wash work clothes separately from other clothes

If you feel sick while working with pesticides:

- Leave the area
- Tell your employer you feel sick, start first aid if needed
- Go to a doctor or clinic
- Have someone go with you
- Tell the doctor the pesticide name. Your employer must provide this information
